As an option, Operators can install a new light on the bottom surface of the Freon plate assembly in the baggage compartment. This light (together with the cargo door light) gives the baggage compartment a second and better source of light when the compartment is in use.

- · Assemble and install the new light and related components
- · Replace or install as necessary the applicable switch assembly
- Replace the installed 1 Amp circuit breaker with a 3 Amp circuit breaker
- Install and/or modify the applicable electrical cables (wires)
